Subject: Fine and Gross Motor Development Activities

Academic Year: 2024–2025

Age Group: 3–4 Years

Motor development is essential for a child's overall growth. This syllabus is designed to enhance **fine motor skills** (small muscle movements like writing, grasping, and hand-eye coordination) and **gross motor skills** (large muscle movements like running, jumping, and balancing). The syllabus is divided into two semesters, with activities progressively building coordination, strength, and confidence.

Semester 1: Basic Motor Skill Development

Month 1: Introduction to Basic Movements

Gross Motor Skills:

- Walking in a straight line
- Balancing on one foot for a few seconds
- Gentle stretching exercises
- Free play with balls (rolling and catching)

Fine Motor Skills:

- Finger painting and palm printing
- Holding crayons and scribbling
- Stacking small blocks
- Playing with dough (rolling, squeezing, pinching)

Month 2: Hand-Eye Coordination & Balance

Gross Motor Skills:

• Hopping on two feet

- Jumping over small obstacles
- Throwing a soft ball towards a target
- Dancing to rhythmic music

Fine Motor Skills:

- Using finger puppets
- Stringing large beads onto a thread
